ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

LANGUAGE

The examination will be held in English, which consists of a report writing component and an oral exam. Your command over English should be sufficient to:

1. Write a nuclear medicine report clearly, explaining the procedure, findings, probable diagnosis, differential diagnosis and the next step in patient management.
2. Discuss a nuclear medicine scan with your examiner during the oral part of the exam.

You will need to certify the level of your understanding and communicating in the English language.

RESEARCH ABSTRACT & POSTER

1. A 300 word abstract for the poster presentation is required to be submitted at the time of application. The abstract must be in the form of a research project, with the headings of “**Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion and Conclusion**”. Case reports are not acceptable. Abstracts not submitted in this format will require resubmission/rejected.
2. You **MUST** also submit the abstract to the KSNM meeting (website will open in July 2026, abstract submission deadline is 17th August 2026). The meeting website is: <https://www.ksnm.or.kr/eng/meetings/view.php>
3. You will be required to prepare a poster based on this abstract. The poster should also have the headings of “**Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion and Conclusion**”. You will need to participate in the poster session at the KSNM/ARCCNM Poster Session on 6th November 2026, following the conclusion of your exam, regardless of your result. The poster dimensions will be advised by the organisers of the KSNM/ARCCNM after submission.

4. Registration with the national medical council (needs to be current)
